HealthPathways WA is a secure, free-to-access clinical support tool available to general practitioners (and other health professionals) in Western Australia. Condition-specific pathways summarise best practice for assessing, managing and referring patients across WA.

- Access condition specific tools, resources and Referral Access Criteria (RAC) (where available), as well as GPbook and visiting specialist rosters.
